


Welcome to Fusehill Street Campus! Let's go and visit the library.

This is the main entrance to Skiddaw building.










You will see the sign, the library is on the second floor.

This is the entrance to the library.


Just inside the library are the library kiosks and the printer, along with lockers with laptops for you to borrow




Turn right and you can find a group study area.



Head past the study area and you will find the law collection and the print journals. There is another study area and the teaching practice collection at this end of the library.












This is the collection of print journals.

booked in advance.











This is the reservation shelf.

You will also find the main lending collection in this area of the library.








Past the library desk is another bookable group study room.
